

THE FARM ECO ESTATE FISHING RULES

All persons wishing to fish must comply with the following rules and guidelines which are applicable to all dams and streams at all times on the estate:

1. Catch and release apply at all times. **(Not allowed to catch for the pan).**
2. Fish may only be removed from dams if they are to be released in other dams located on The Farm.

(Subject to “Pond Management Instructions” to be implemented later).

3. Only residents and their guests are allowed to fish on the Farm Estate.
4. Guests must be accompanied by the resident.
5. Children under the age of 12 years must be accompanied by an adult.
6. Proper fishing practices to be followed at all times.
7. No kick boats or canoes are allowed.
8. In the event that your fishing line gets entangled or snapped off, it must be retrieved and discarded at home.

(Abandoned fishing line is lethal to other animals and more so birds).

9. Extreme care must be taken to remove all entangled fishing line and hooks.
10. No rubbish whatsoever may be left behind after fishing.
11. No foreign objects of any kind may be thrown into the water.
12. All wildlife must be treated with respect and not be scared especially during breeding and mating season.
13. No fires are allowed on the property.
